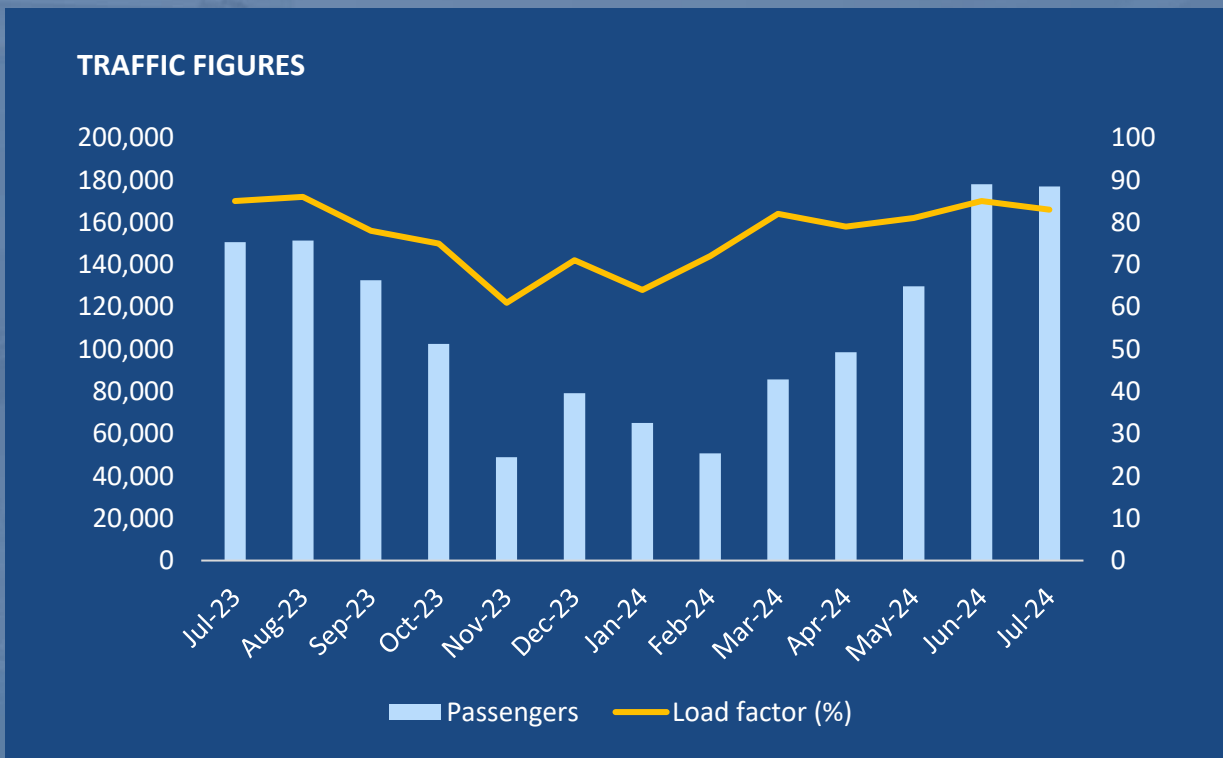


## Norse Atlantic ASA Reports Load Factor Of 83 Per Cent In July

The month saw an average load factor of 83 per cent, representing a decrease of two percentage points (p.p.) year on year. During July, Norse Atlantic Airways had 176,934 passengers, representing an increase of 17 per cent across 639 flights compared to a year earlier, including nine charters operated during the month. 73 per cent of flights arrived within 15 minutes of their scheduled arrival time with a completion rate of 98 per cent.

**ASK (Available Seat Kilometers):** Number of available passenger seats multiplied by flight distance. | **Completion:** Percentage of scheduled flights that operated. | **LF (Load Factor):** A measure of how efficiently seats are filled, found by dividing RPK by ASK. | **Punctuality:** Aircraft arrived within 15 minutes of the scheduled arrival time. Indicates on time performance. | **RPK (Revenue Passenger Kilometers):** Number of sold seats multiplied by flight distance.
