


## NORSE ATLANTIC TRAFFIC FIGURES JULY 2025

## Norse Atlantic delivers strong growth with 94% load factor

In July, Norse Atlantic Airways recorded a load factor of 94%, representing an 11 %-points increase from 83% in the same month the previous year. The load factor of scheduled network also was 94%, compared to 82% in July 2024. The Company operated 658 flights and transported 203,712 passengers across its network and ACMI/charter operations, a 15% increase in passenger numbers. 70% of the flights departed within 15 minutes of their scheduled departure time, up 1%-points year-over-year. Air Traffic Control (ATC) delays and airport congestions continue to impact on-time performance. Norse operated 54 ACMI/charter flights in July 2025, compared to nine in July 2024.

ASK (Available Seat Kilometers): Number of available passenger seats multiplied by flight distance. | Completion: Percentage of scheduled flights that operated. | LF (Load Factor): A measure of how efficiently seats are filled, found by dividing RPK by ASK. | Punctuality: Aircraft departed within 15 minutes of the scheduled departure time. Indicates on-time performance. | RPK (Revenue Passenger Kilometers): Number of sold seats multiplied by flight distance.
